Investigators Seek Tips in Sandusky County Arson

(COLUMBUS, Ohio) — The Division of State Fire Marshal's Fire and Explosion Investigation Bureau is seeking tips from the public regarding an intentionally set fire at a home in Bellevue (Sandusky County).

The Bellevue Fire Department responded to the fire, which occurred at 3:53 a.m. April 10 at 203 Belle Ave. The home was occupied by four adults and two juveniles at the time of the fire. Two of the adults, Natalia Cramer and Joseph Mira, sustained burn injuries and suffered from smoke inhalation, and were transported to Fisher Titus Medical Center in Norwalk and then to the burn center at Metro Health Medical Center in Cleveland.

The residence sustained significant damage as a result of the fire, along with damage to one of the neighboring homes. The investigation is being conducted jointly by the State Fire Marshal's office and the Bellevue police and fire departments.

A reward of up to \$5,000 is being offered by the [Blue Ribbon Arson Committee](#) for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the fire.
