Investigators Seek Tips in Ross County Arson

(COLUMBUS, Ohio) — The Division of State Fire Marshal's Fire and Explosion Investigation Bureau is seeking tips from the public regarding an intentionally set fire at a home in Twin Township (Ross County).

At approximately 5:45 a.m. on Sept. 11, the Twin Township Fire Department responded to 2170 Harris Station Road to find the home fully engulfed in flames. Due to the damages, the structure has been deemed a total loss.

The investigation is being conducted jointly by the State Fire Marshal's office and the Twin Township Fire Department. Investigators are interested in speaking to anyone who may have witnessed the fire in its early stages or noticed anything prior to the incident.

A reward of up to \$5,000 is being offered by the [Blue Ribbon Arson Committee](#) for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this fire.
