Public Meetings Scheduled for the Week of August 16, 2021

The Board of Building Standards Certification and Education Committees will meet on Friday, August 20, at 10 a.m. at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, Training Rm 3, Reynoldsburg.

The Certification and Education Committees review building departments, building department personnel and continuing education applications and make recommendations to the Board of Building Standards. The committees also review and make recommendations to the Board on other personnel and education-related issues.

The Board of Building Standards will meet on Friday, August 20, at 1 p.m. at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, Training Room 1, Reynoldsburg

The Board of Building Standards formulates and adopts rules governing the Ohio Residential and Non-Residential Building Codes. The Board also certifies municipal, county and township building departments to enforce the Ohio Residential and Non-Residential Codes.

The Ohio Construction Industry Licensing Board (OCILB), HVAC Section, will meet on Wednesday, August 18, 2021 beginning at 10:00 a.m. This meeting is being conducted in person at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, OCILB Conference Room, Reynoldsburg.

OCILB issues licenses to qualified electrical, Heating Ventilating and Air Conditioning (HVAC), plumbing, hydronics and refrigeration contractors who successfully pass a licensing examination. The Board sections review applicants before they are approved to take the test for a particular trade. The Board sections also issue disciplinary actions as well as review late renewals and continuing education courses.

The tentatively scheduled August 18, 2021, Ohio Home Inspector Board meeting has been canceled.

The Ohio Home Inspector Board reviews orders and application determinations and hears appeals from orders regarding claims brought against the home inspection recovery fund. If a licensee is found to have violated licensing law, the Board may order disciplinary action which could include suspending or revoking a license, accepting surrender of the license in lieu of discipline, issuing a reprimand, assessing a fine or ordering additional continuing education.
