The Board of Building Standards Code Committee will meet in a Special Meeting on Friday, September 17 at 9:00 a.m. at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, Training Rm 3, Reynoldsburg to review the International Energy Conservation Code.

The Code Committee reviews petitions for building code changes and makes recommendations to the Board of Building Standards.

The Board of Building Standards will meet on Friday, September 17, at 1 p.m. at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, Training Rm 1, Reynoldsburg.

The Board of Building Standards formulates and adopts rules governing the Ohio Residential and Non-Residential Building Codes. The Board also certifies municipal, county and township building departments to enforce the Ohio Residential and Non-Residential Codes.
