2021 Ohio Securities Conference Focuses on Issues and Challenges in 2021

(COLUMBUS, Ohio) - Industry experts, legal scholars, securities brokers and regulators will meet virtually on Friday, Oct. 22, to discuss issues facing the investment industry and the Ohioans who invest their money in a variety of products during the 2021 Ohio Securities Conference. The conference runs from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

The theme of the virtual conference, co-sponsored by the Ohio Division of Securities and the University of Toledo College of Law, is "The State of the Private Markets in 2021 & Beyond."

The conference features presentations by industry experts from the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission, state securities regulators from Washington and Texas, and compliance representatives from broker-dealers and investment firms.
