The Ohio Real Estate Appraiser Board will meet on Thursday, November 18, beginning at 9:30 a.m. The meeting will be held in person at 77 S. High St., 22nd Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

The Ohio Real Estate Appraiser Board oversees the operation of Ohio's real estate appraiser registration, licensure and certification program. If a registered, licensed or certified appraiser is found to have violated appraiser law, the Board can revoke or suspend a registration, license or certification, assess a fine or order additional continuing education.

The Board of Building Standards Certification and Education Committees will meet on Thursday, November 18 at 10 a.m. at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, Training Rm 3, Reynoldsburg.

The Certification and Education Committees review building departments, building department personnel and continuing education applications and make recommendations to the Board of Building Standards. The committees also review and make recommendations to the Board on other personnel and education-related issues.

The Board of Building Standards Code Committee will meet on Thursday, November 18 at 1 p.m. at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, Training Rm 3, Reynoldsburg.

The Code Committee reviews petitions for building code changes and makes recommendations to the Board of Building Standards.
