## **Public Meetings Scheduled for the Week of December 11, 2017**

The Backflow Advisory Board will meet on Tuesday, December 12, at 10 a.m. at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, Conference Room 1, Reynoldsburg\*.

The Backflow Advisory Board advises the Superintendent of the Division of Industrial Compliance on matters pertaining to the training and certification of backflow technicians.

The Ohio Real Estate Commission will meet on Wednesday, December 13, at 9 a.m. at the Division of Real Estate and Professional Licensing, 77 South High Street, 22<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Columbus.

The Ohio Real Estate Commission reviews hearing examiner reports and settlement agreements each month regarding alleged real estate license law violations and considers licensee appeals on licensure issues. If a licensee is found to have violated licensing law, the Commission can revoke or suspend a license, assess a fine, order additional continuing education, or issue a public reprimand.

The Plumbing Section of the Ohio Construction Industry Licensing Board (OCILB) will meet on Wednesday, December 13 at 10 a.m. at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, OCILB Conference Room, Reynoldsburg\*.

OCILB issues licenses to qualified electrical, Heating Ventilating and Air Conditioning (HVAC), plumbing, hydronics and refrigeration contractors who successfully pass a licensing examination. The Board sections review applicants before they are approved to take the test for a particular trade. The Board sections also issue disciplinary actions as well as review late renewals and continuing education courses.

The Board of Building Standards Certification and Education Committee will meet at 10 a.m. and the Code Committee will meet at 1 p.m. on Thursday, December 14, at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, Training Room 1, Reynoldsburg\*.

The Certification and Education Committee reviews building departments, building department personnel and continuing education applications and make recommendations to the Board of Building Standards. The committees also review and make recommendations to the Board on other personnel and education-related issues. The Code Committee reviews petitions for building code changes and makes recommendations to the Board of Building Standards.

The Board of Building Standards will meet on Friday, December 15, at 10 a.m. at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, Training Room 1, Reynoldsburg\*.

The Board of Building Standards formulates and adopts rules governing the Ohio Residential and Non-Residential Building Codes. The Board also certifies municipal, county and township building departments to enforce the Ohio Residential and Non-Residential Codes.
