Public Meetings Scheduled for the Week of July 9, 2018

The Manufactured Homes Advisory Council will meet at 10 a.m. on Monday, July 9 at the Vern Riffe Center, 77 South High Street, 22nd floor, Columbus.

The Manufactured Homes Advisory Council is made up of appointed members who have knowledge or expertise of the manufactured homes industry. The council advises the Director of the Department of Commerce concerning the director's duties in the regulation of manufactured housing in Ohio.

The State Fire Council will meet on Wednesday, July 11, at 11:00 a.m. at the Division of State Fire Marshal, 8895 East Main Street, Reynoldsburg.

The State Fire Council makes recommendations to the Governor, the General Assembly and other state agencies about any needed changes in laws, rules or administrative policies relating to fire safety. The Council also may recommend revision of the rules in the State Fire Code adopted by the State Fire Marshal.

The Ohio Real Estate Commission will meet on Wednesday, July 11 at 9 a.m. at the Division of Real Estate and Professional Licensing, 77 South High Street, 22nd Floor, Columbus.

The Ohio Real Estate Commission reviews hearing examiner reports and settlement agreements each month regarding alleged real estate license law violations and considers licensee appeals on licensure issues. If a licensee is found to have violated licensing law, the Commission can revoke or suspend a license, assess a fine, order additional continuing education, or issue a public reprimand.

The Cemetery Dispute Resolution Commission will meet on Thursday, July 12, at 10 a.m. at the Division of Real Estate and Professional Licensing, 77 South High Street, 22nd Floor, Columbus.

The Commission assists in resolving complaints against registered cemeteries by using informal techniques of mediation, conciliation and persuasion. The Commission hears complaints brought by individuals who are experiencing a problem with a cemetery.

The Board of Building Standards Certification and Education Committees will meet at 10 a.m. on Thursday, July 12, and the Code Committee will meet at 1 p.m. on Thursday, July 12 at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, BBS Library, Reynoldsburg.

The Certification and Education Committees review building departments, building department personnel and continuing education applications and make recommendations to the Board of Building Standards. The Code Committee reviews petitions for building code changes and makes recommendations to the Board of Building Standards.

The Board of Building Standards will meet on Friday, July 13 at 10 a.m. at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, Training Room 1, Reynoldsburg.

The Board of Building Standards formulates and adopts rules governing the Ohio Residential and Non-Residential Building Codes. The Board also certifies municipal, county and township building departments to enforce the Ohio Residential and Non-Residential Codes.
