## **Public Meetings Scheduled for the Week of Oct. 15, 2018**

The Administrative Section of the Ohio Construction Industry Licensing Board (OCILB) will meet at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, Oct. 17 at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, OCILB Conference Room, Reynoldsburg.

OCILB issues licenses to qualified electrical, Heating Ventilating and Air Conditioning (HVAC), plumbing, hydronics and refrigeration contractors who successfully pass a licensing examination. The Board sections review applicants before they are approved to take the test for a particular trade. The Board sections also issue disciplinary actions as well as review late renewals and continuing education courses.

The Credit Union Council will meet on Wednesday, Oct. 17, at 10:30 a.m. at 77 South High Street, 21st Floor, Columbus. The meeting will begin with a rules hearing to review proposed administrative rules for Ohio-chartered credit unions and will be followed by the regular council meeting agenda items.

The Credit Union Council advises the Superintendent of Financial Institutions and the Deputy Superintendent for Credit Unions on any matters submitted to it by the Division related to credit union laws and rules, and confirms the annual schedule of assessments.

The Historical Boiler Licensing Board has a meeting on Wednesday, Oct. 17 at 10 a.m. for a regular meeting and at 1 p.m. for a special meeting to review Ohio Administrative Rules. Both meetings will take place in the Superintendent's Conference Room at 6606 Tussing Road, Reynoldsburg, OH 43068.

The Historical Boiler Licensing Board ensures public safety through the adoption of rules governing the criteria that inspectors of historical boilers utilize in determining the safe operation of historical boilers. In addition, the board approves historical boiler operator courses and issues operator licenses to those individuals qualified to operate historical boilers in public.

The Board of Building Appeals will meet at 8:30 a.m. on Friday, Oct. 19 at the Ohio Department of Transportation, District three Office, Conference Room, 906 Clark Avenue in Ashland.

The Board of Building Appeals reviews appeals to adjudication orders issued by the Division of Industrial Compliance, Bureaus of Building Code Compliance and Operations and Maintenance, or by any certified local or county enforcement agency. The Board also reviews appeals made to fire citations issued by the State Fire Marshal or any local fire department with a certified fire safety inspector. The Board can reverse or modify orders of the enforcing agencies and can also grant vacancies and exemptions to certain code requirements.
