****EDIT NOV. 13: PLEASE NOTE THE TIME CHANGE FOR THE BOARD OF BUILDING STANDARDS CERTIFICATION AND EDUCATION COMMITTEE MEETING****

Ski Tramway has an upcoming meeting scheduled for 11 a.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 12 at the Division of Industrial Compliance, Training Room 3, 6606 Tussing Road, Reynoldsburg, OH 4306

The Ski Tramway Board regulates the construction, maintenance, mechanical operation, and inspection of passenger tramways that are associated with ski areas and of registering operators of passenger tramways in this state.

The Ohio Real Estate Commission will meet at 9 a.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 13 at the Division of Real Estate and Professional Licensing, 77 South High Street, 22nd Floor, Columbus.

The Ohio Real Estate Commission reviews hearing examiner reports and settlement agreements each month regarding alleged real estate license law violations and considers licensee appeals on licensure issues. If a licensee is found to have violated licensing law, the Commission can revoke or suspend a license, assess a fine, order additional continuing education, or issue a public reprimand.

The State Fire Council will meet at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 13 at the Division of State Fire Marshal, 8895 East Main Street, Reynoldsburg.

The State Fire Council makes recommendations to the Governor, the General Assembly and other state agencies about any needed changes in laws, rules or administrative policies relating to fire safety. The Council also may recommend revision of the rules in the State Fire Code adopted by the State Fire Marshal.

The Certification and Education Committees review building departments, building department personnel and continuing education applications and make recommendations to the Board of Building Standards.

The Real Estate Appraiser Board will meet at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, Nov. 14 at the Division of Real Estate and Professional Licensing, 77 South High Street, 22nd Floor, Columbus.

The Ohio Real Estate Appraiser Board oversees the operation of Ohio's real estate appraiser registration, licensure and certification program. If a registered, licensed or certified appraiser is found to have violated appraiser law, the Board can revoke or suspend a registration, license or certification, assess a fine or order additional continuing education.

The Board of Building Standards will meet at 10 a.m. on Friday, Nov. 15 at the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, Training Rm 1, Reynoldsburg.

The Board of Building Standards formulates and adopts rules governing the Ohio Residential and Non-Residential Building Codes. The Board also certifies municipal, county and township building departments to enforce the Ohio Residential and Non-Residential Codes.
